### **Monitoring Device Driving Permit**

The Illinois Secretary of State has adopted amendments to implement various Public Acts which authorize the issuance by the circuit courts of a “Monitoring Device Driving Permit” (“MDDP”). This permit is a 24 hour, 7 days per week permit to “first time DUI offenders” upon the installation of a breath alcohol ignition interlock device (“BAIID”) in the offender’s vehicle(s). This permit is not a restricted driving permit. The holder of the MDDP must have their BAIID devices inspected every 60 days or send a part of the device to the provider by mail to have the results reported to the Secretary of State’s office. The Secretary of State’s office will take various actions due to violations of the MDDP.
